# Bricks cubes

Designed by Ditte Vad and Julie Begtrup

## English text

The Bricks series is a refined storage system that emphasises Scandinavian design traditions through fine craftsmanship and minimalistic aesthetics. The simple modular cubes encourage the creation of a personal arrangement. Build it brick by brick and create a changeable storage setting, a room divider, a wall-mounted bookcase, a side table or a display for objects.

The construction of Bricks is simple. Every brick is made out of five oak boards. The different levels of the boards make it possible to stack the Bricks on top of each other, creating a self-locking construction.

Bricks were designed to solve the designers' personal desire to have a changeable storage system to showcase carefully chosen objects but also to hide away the mess that often occurs in everyday life.

## Designed by Ditte Vad and Julie Begtrup

The two Danish design talents studied together and found that they shared the same aesthetic sense, view on materials and expressions in their designs. With a belief that designers have the opportunity to improve the surroundings, they aim to create honest and functional designs that allows a dynamic interaction between the design and its user.

## Danish text

Bricks er et smukt realsystem, der består af modulære egetræskuber, som opfordrer til at skabe en personlig opbevaringsløsning. Det raffinerede design hylder de skandinaviske designtraditioner, hvor godt håndværk og minimalistisk æstetik forenes i en enkel og tidløs kube.

Bricks er formet af fem egetræssider, der er sammensat i forskellige niveauer, hvilket gør det muligt at stable elementerne oven på hinanden i en selvlåsende konstruktion. Skab en rumdeler, vægophængt bogreol eller vend kuben på højkant som et sidebord.

Bricks er inspireret af designernes personlige ønske om at have et modulært, elegant opbevarings-system, der både kan dekorerer med personlige genstande og samtidig skjule hverdagens rod.
